Finances

Total cost for *Crossings for Kids Camp* is \$199. Most have paid a \$75 deposit leaving a balance due of **\$124**. Please make your check payable to St. Matthews Baptist Church. If possible, we would appreciate having that before departure as we have to make our final payment two weeks before departure. Forms

Go online to www.crossingscamps.org and click on the icon that says **GET READY FOR CAMP/STUDENTS**. On the next page, click on **CAMP FORMS**, then **Medical Release and POI forms login**. Next, sign in as a **NEW PARTICIPANT**. That will take you to a page where you will confirm some information about our church. From there, you will be taken to a page that will ask you for personal information (name/birthday/gender/grade/email). Once you submit this information, you will be given a **Participant ID Number** which you will want to write down (it will also be emailed to you).

You will also then have access a **Medical Release Form** and a **POI**. I will need two copies of the Medical Release Form, and one must be **NOTARIZED**. (Tomara Brown is a notary if you want to drop by the church.) Bring them to me before we depart. The POI form will give your camper the opportunity to choose specific activities for camp. I will not need a copy of it. (POI choices can be edited or changed later if you like.)

The next time you sign in, you can use the Participant ID and login as a returning camper.
